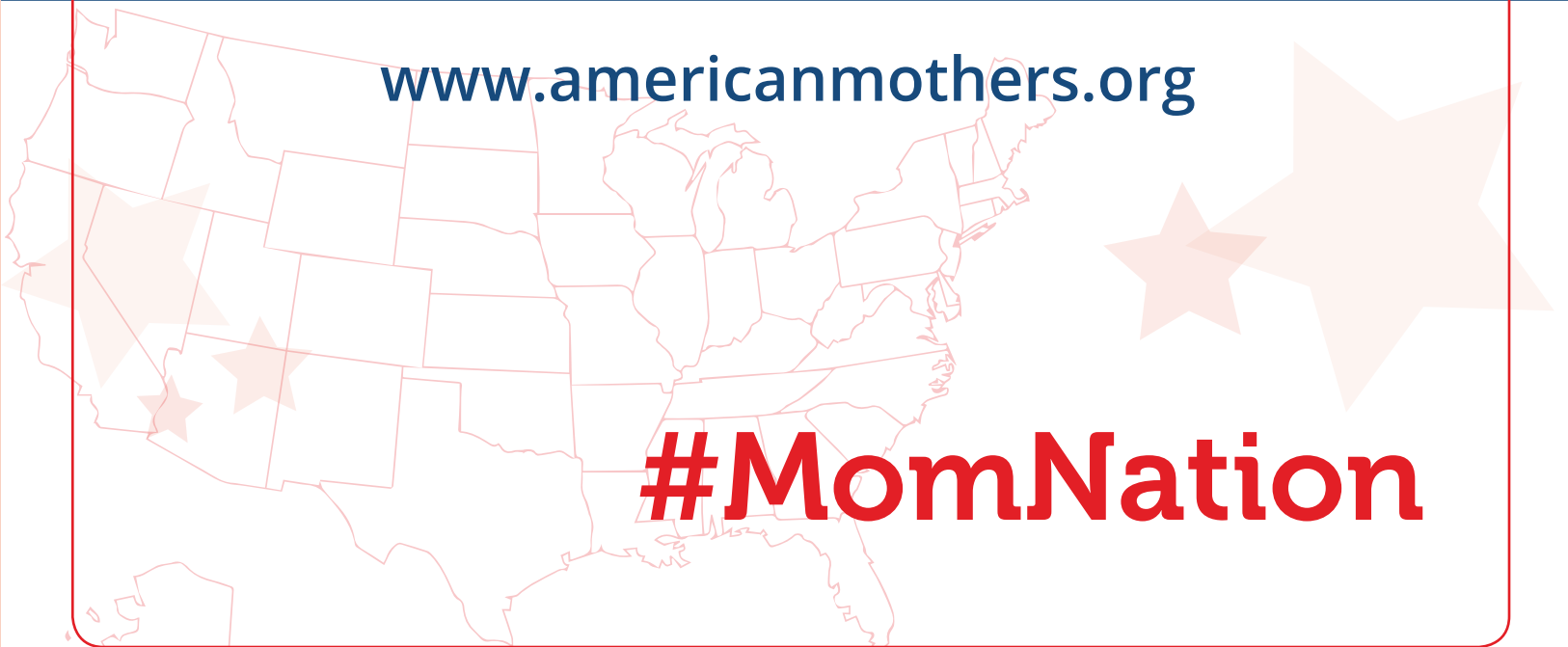

**CLAUDIA PEACOCK:** Claudia grew up in a dysfunctional family with an alcoholic father and a mother who worked two jobs to support eight children. As the second oldest, Claudia's responsibility at a young age was to help care for her younger siblings which had a huge impact on who she is today.

Claudia worked part-time in high school so she could help her parents with the bills and was hired by the U.S. Department of Justice as a clerk-typist. She graduated from George Mason University in 2004, Cum Laude with a degree in Government and International Politics. After 37 years with the federal government, she retired as a GS-14, Special Assistant to the Director of the United States Marshals Service.

Claudia and her husband had three children when she and her husband were motivated to become foster parents. While leaving church they happened to see an article on a bulletin board recruiting foster parents. They wanted their children to not take for granted their many blessings and the love and security in their home.

During their 27 years as foster parents they have seen it all. They have had babies, toddlers, grade school children, teenagers, pregnant teenagers, children with serious disabilities, and sibling groups. They even received a sibling group of three on December 23rd, two days before Christmas...This was the best Christmas ever!

Claudia's life as a child and her success as an adult inspired her to help children in situations similar to her own. She wanted foster children to feel that they too can make something out of their lives and not dwell on the past but look forward to what lies ahead...never give up.

In addition to keeping foster children, Claudia has also served as a foster parent co-trainer and in 2008, she and her husband were named Foster Parents of the Year.



**LORI CASH RICHARDS:** Lori Cash Richards, M.A. is a graduate of the University of Santa Monica where she earned her master's degree in Spiritual Psychology with an emphasis in Consciousness, Health and Healing. Her work as a writer, life coach, workshop facilitator and speaker centers on serving global transformation of consciousness in the individual.

She is the author of the book, Letting the Upside In, which examines the code that grants us access to the sanctuary of our own loving hearts and the limitless treasures waiting within get released. A most celebrated historic Washington DC hotel, the Willard InterContinental Washington, has been the focal point for elegant dinners, meetings, and gala social events for more than 150 years. An institution, this grand Washington DC historic hotel has hosted almost every U.S. president since Franklin Pierce in 1853. On August 28, 1963, the Reverend Martin Luther King finished his famous "I Have A Dream" speech while a guest at the Willard. Other notable guests have included Charles Dickens, Buffalo Bill, David Lloyd George, P.T. Barnum, Lord and Lady Napier, and countless others. Walt Whitman mentioned the hotel in his works; and Mark Twain penned two books here in the early 1900s. Throughout the ages, no phrase has raised eyebrows like "I'm staying at the Willard."
